

# A LETTER FROM THE PRESIDENT OF IFOSuD

Dear Donors,

Thank you so much for choosing to honor our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ through the hopes and dreams of others. It is a great privilege for IFOSUD to receive your generous gifts.

During the year 2021 we had the privilege to witness God's mercy towards IFOSuD operations in Haiti. Haiti dwelt in a political labyrinth and economic crisis that devastated neighborhoods of Haiti, time and time again. We are praying and working hard to see Hope rise through the ashes. **IFOSUD is standing on Jesus as the powerful Cornerstone; that's why we continue to plant the seed of Hope and to grow the nation of Haiti.**

For people living in poverty on the margins of society, your support means hope, Christian education for children and adults, food production, technical assistance, microloans, and counseling. We can confess that your gifts are worth more than that. **It is the expressions of your compassions for your Haitian fellows and your obedience to the Word of God.**

God has continuously given IFOSUD the opportunity to evangelize more people than expected. In order to reach out our beneficiaries we used several strategies like story-telling, Christian movie projections, group devotions, group discussions, and household discipleship visits. This has allowed us to develop confidence between the communities and IFOSUD. Throughout our project communities 66 devotion sessions have been realized and 153 discipleship visits were realized either by Field Agent or IFOSuD Staff. In addition to that, 300 Bibles have been given away to students enrolled in the Future Farmers of Haiti Program!

**During this year, all the people that have accepted Jesus or restored their relations with the Lord Jesus are strengthened in their faith and seem to be ready to make disciples.** Furthermore, two beneficiaries that were living out of wedlock decided to legalize in the Lord's eyes and got married.

Again, amongst the non-Christian beneficiaries we have noticed many changes in their attitudes towards the acceptance of the Gospel. This change in attitude has been monitored within 4 steps: attitude in prayer time, attitude during story-telling time, attitude in self-application of the Scriptures, and the participant's commitment to share the gospel.

Truthfully, we could not do this without you. We, and those we serve, sincerely appreciate your generosity.

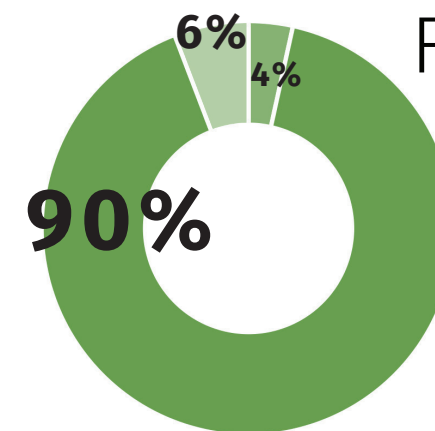
## MOVING FORWARD

- >> **52** Bible stories were taught and have been mastered by the farmers in 2021.
- >> **Dozens** of people have been saved.
- >> **59** beneficiaries have been trained and are getting ready for their upcoming Farmer Field School graduation on March 20, 2022.
- >> **Two** brand new groups with **83** beneficiaries in Bongnotte + Lompre began.
- >> Leogane + Gressier are taking classes regularly and have already received their first microloan.
- >> **330** school children are taking Ag Class in the Future Farmers of Haiti (FFH) program.
- >> **7** graduated beneficiaries are performing in honey production with **42** hives total.
- >> **25** adults enrolled in Farmer Field School are regularly attending their literacy class.
